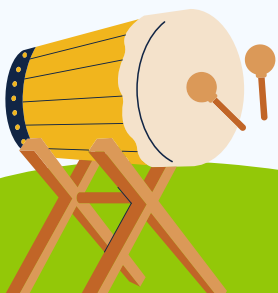
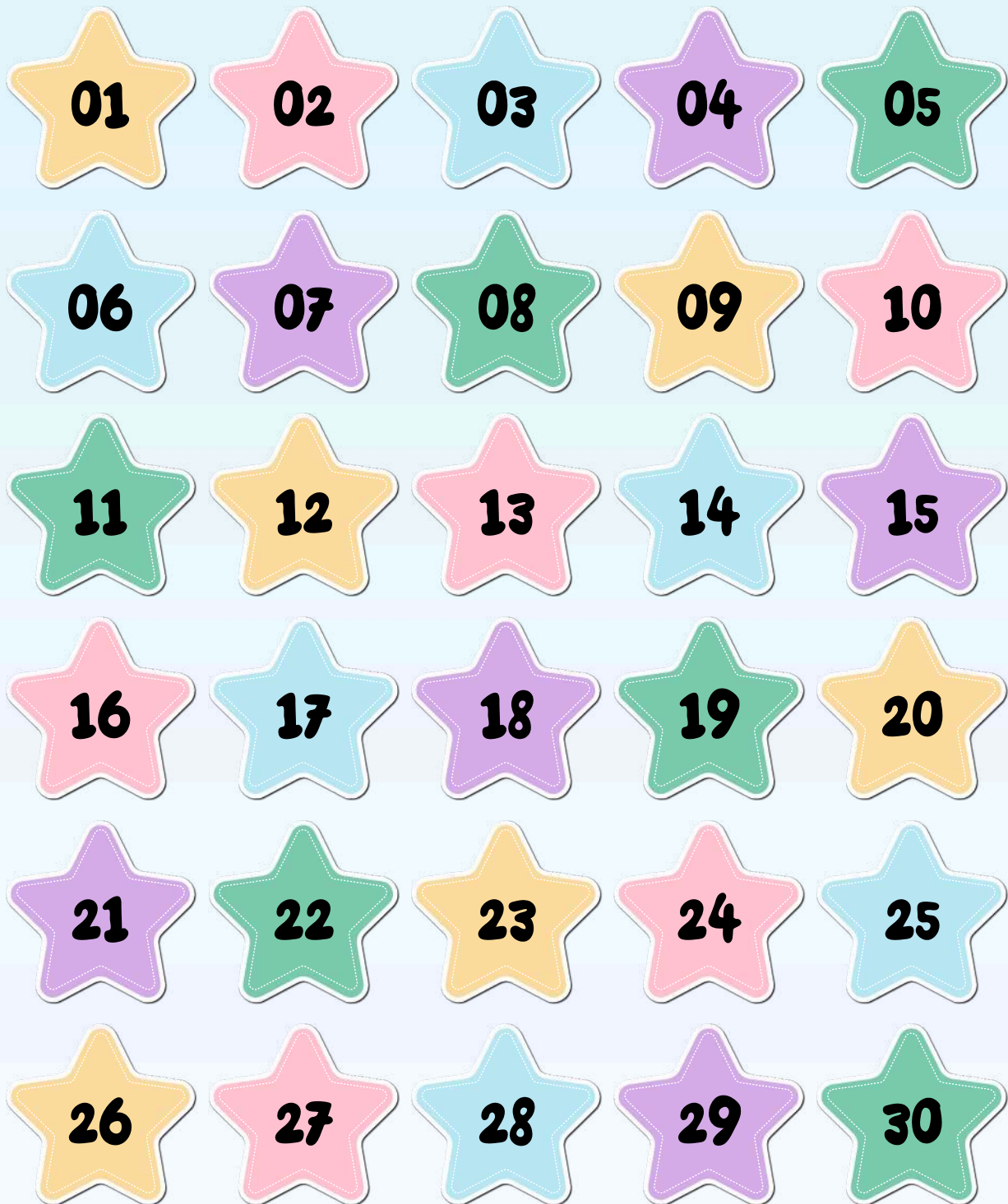

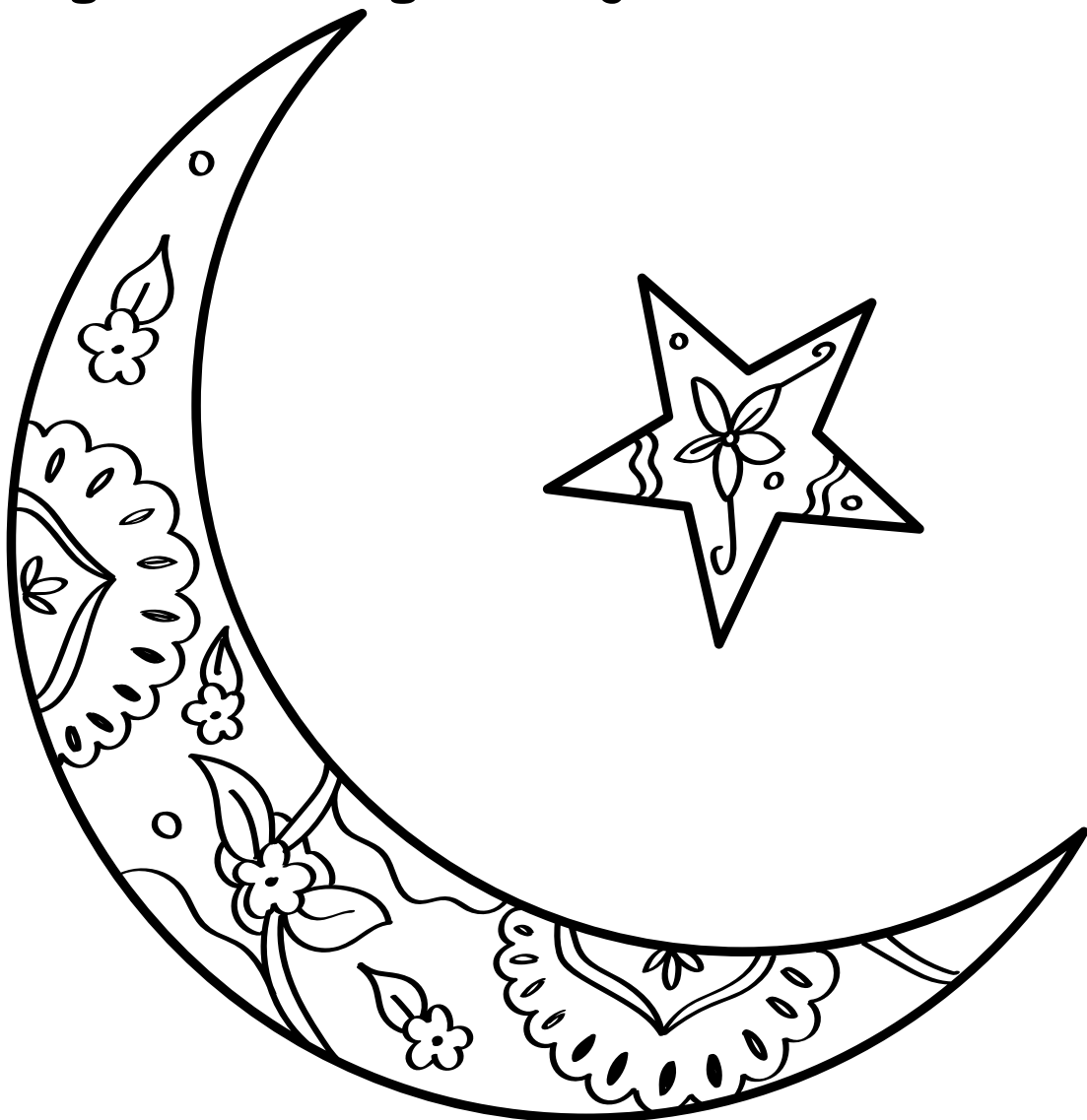
RAJAB

Rajab is a special month celebrated by Muslims all over the world. During the month, Muslims practise fasting to get ready and prepare for Ramadan.

Allahumma barik lana fi Rajab wa Sha'ban wa ballighna Ramadan."

("O Allah, bless us in Rajab and Sha'ban and allow us to reach Ramadan.")

The Night Journey (Isra and Miraj)



The Night Journey (Isra and Miraj)

in the sacred month of Rajab, the Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ) was blessed with the miraculous journey of Isra and Miraj. He was taken from Masjid al-Haram in Makkah to Masjid al-Aqsa in Jerusalem (Isra) and ascended to the heavens (Miraj). During this journey, he met various prophets, was gifted with the command of Salah (prayer), and witnessed the wonders of Paradise and the punishments of Hellfire.

Detailed Story of Isra and Miraj

The Isra and Miraj is a miraculous journey undertaken by Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ) in the month of Rajab. The journey consists of two parts:

1. The Night Journey (Isra)

The Prophet (ﷺ) Angel Jibreel (AS) took him from Masjid al-Haram in Makkah. He was mounted on Al-Buraq, a heavenly steed, which transported him to Masjid al-Aqsa in Jerusalem.

Significance of Masjid al-Aqsa: This mosque is one of the holiest sites in Islam. At this sacred place, the Prophet (ﷺ) led all the previous prophets in prayer, signifying the unity of the message of Islam.

The Ascension (Miraj)

From Jerusalem, The Prophet (ﷺ) ascended through the seven heavens. At each level, he met a different prophet:

First Heaven: Prophet Adam (AS).

Second Heaven: Prophets isa (AS) and Yahya (AS).

Third Heaven: Prophet Yusuf (AS).

Fourth Heaven: Prophet idris (AS).

Fifth Heaven: Prophet Harun (AS).

Sixth Heaven: Prophet Musa (AS).

Seventh Heaven: Prophet Ibrahim (AS), leaning against Al-Bayt al-Ma'mur (The heavenly Ka'bah).

The Prophet (ﷺ) was then brought into the presence of Allah, where he was gifted the five daily prayers (Salah). Initially, fifty prayers were commanded, but they were reduced to five upon the Prophet's request, while still retaining the reward of fifty.

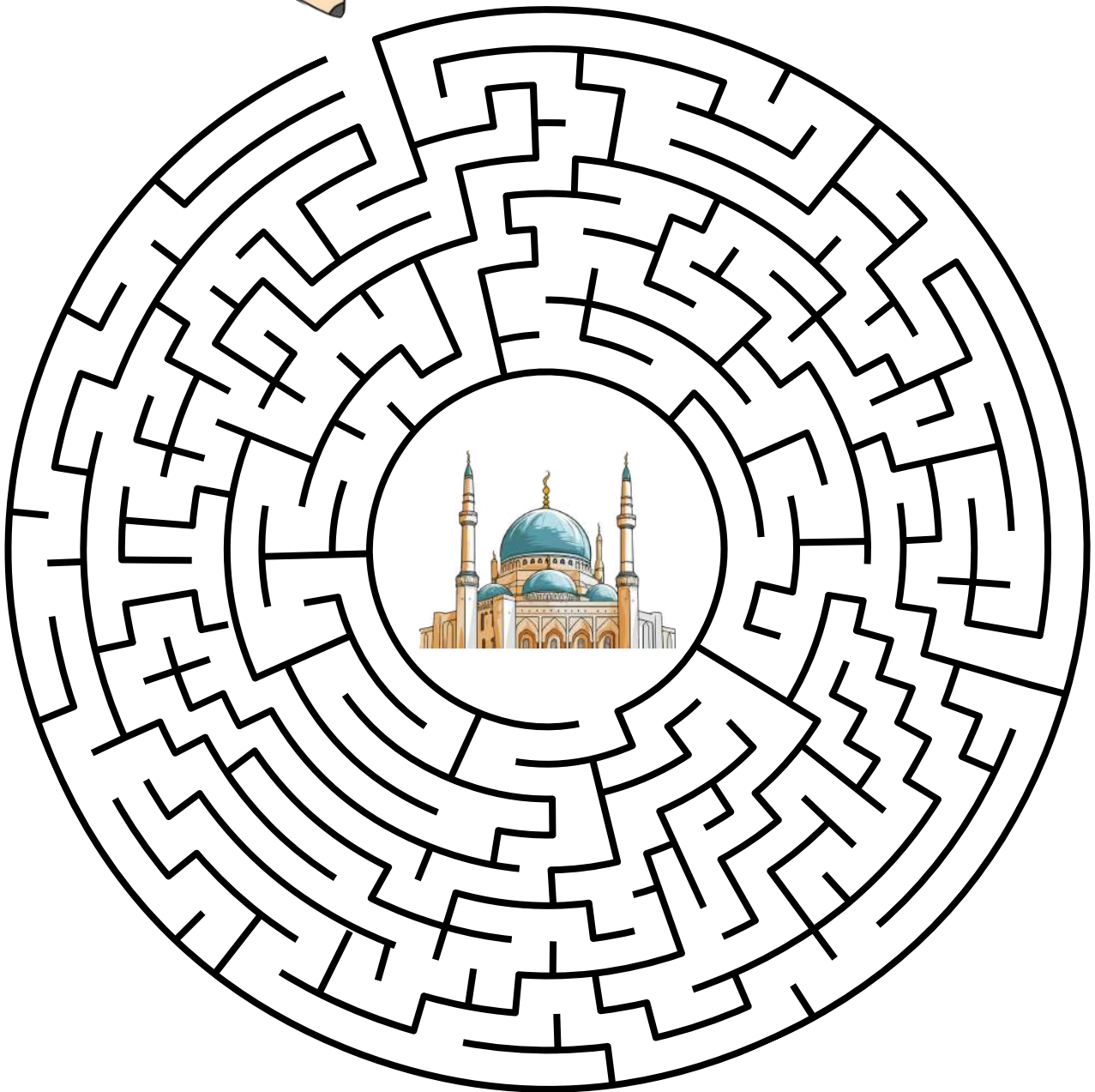

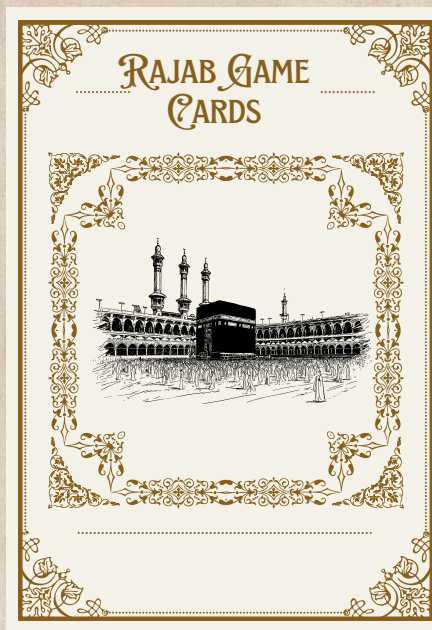
